

Reichert's "9-1-1" Blueprint: Ending Antisemitism in Our Schools

- ONE:** **Adopt International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) Definition of Antisemitism.** IHRA Definition: "Antisemitism is a certain perception of Jews, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jews. Rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism are directed toward Jewish or non-Jewish individuals and/or their property, toward Jewish community institutions and religious facilities."
- TWO:** **Increase Security for Targets of Hate.** We will ensure Judaism and Jewish People are protected by our antidiscrimination policies and laws, train police and school administrators on the IHRA definition of antisemitism, and ensure that law enforcement stands ready to act when members and nonmembers of our schools and universities violate the law.
- THREE:** **Fight Antisemitism Through Education.** We must adopt and enforce campus-wide student and faculty codes of conduct with regard to hate speech toward Jewish People, support school curricula for International Holocaust Remembrance Day and Jewish American Heritage Month, and coordinate interfaith dialogue on prejudice, bigotry, and extremism.
- FOUR:** **Fight Antisemitism at Public & Private Universities Through Online Vigilance.** We will require codes of conduct for university students and faculty members regarding social media and online activities and postings, establish an anonymous reporting system for hateful conduct, as well as monitoring and reporting hateful conduct in digital media.
- FIVE:** **Prohibit Economic Antisemitism.** We will prohibit state investments in, or purchases from, companies that boycott Israel. We also must remove public funding from any companies or firms doing business with or in Iran or any other state sponsors of terrorism.
